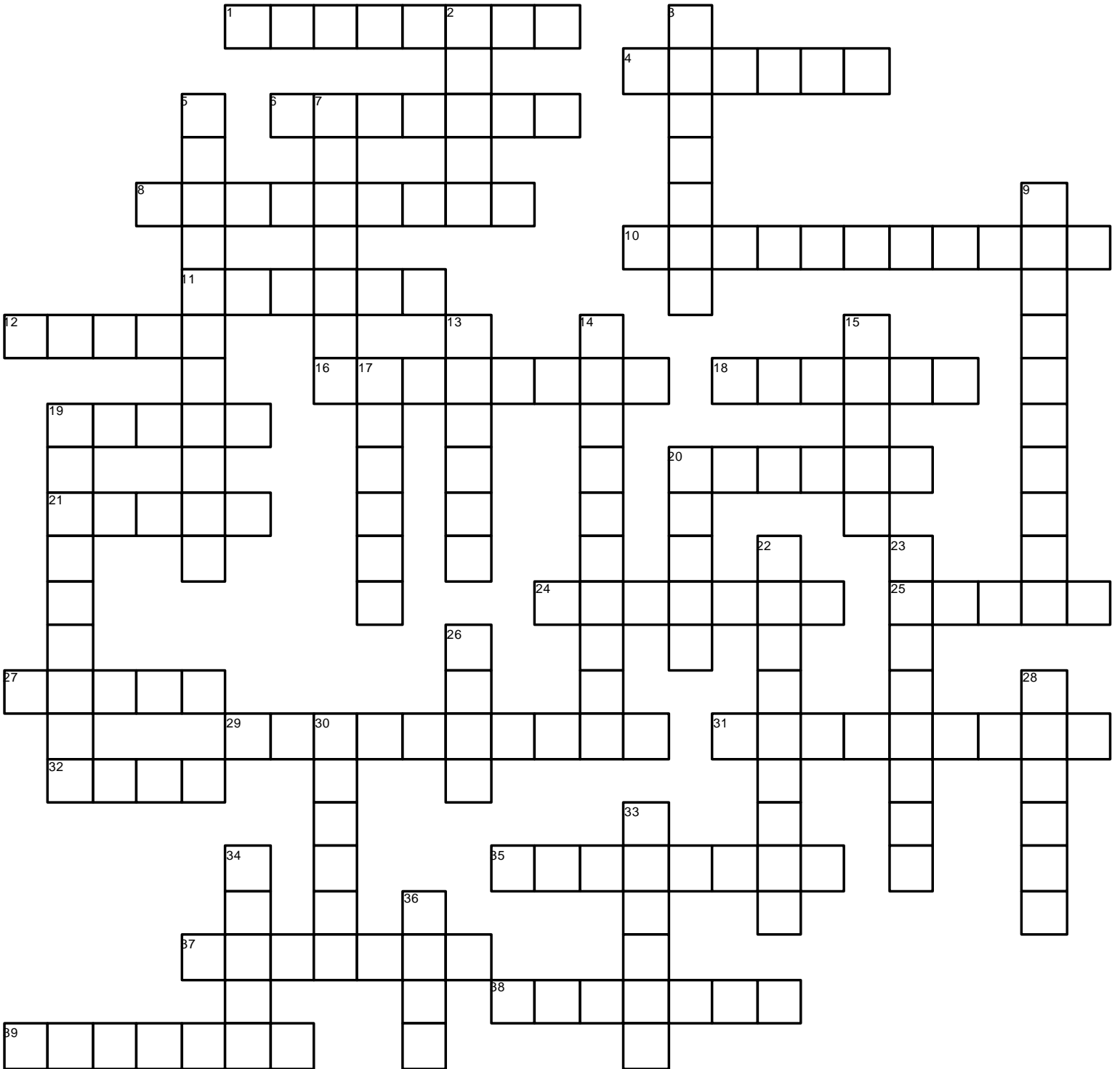


The Gettysburg Address Crossword Puzzle



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The Gettysburg Address

Four (34 D) and (27 A) years ago our fathers brought forth on this (19 D) a new nation, (22 D) in liberty and dedicated to the (10 A) that all men are created equal.

Now we are (7 D) in a great (19 A) war, testing whether that nation, or any nation so conceived and so (31 A), can long (17 D). We are met on a great (5 D) of that war. We have come to (23 D) a (37 A) of that field as a final resting place for those who here gave their (15 D) that that nation might live. It is altogether fitting and (20 A) that we should do this. But, in a (11 A) sense, we cannot dedicate - we cannot (14 D) - we cannot (33 D) - this ground. The (2 D) men, living and dead, who (8 A) here have consecrated it, far above our poor (20 D) to add or (6 A). The world will little note, nor long (1 A) what we say here, but it can never (13 D) what they did here. It is for us the (18 A), rather, to be dedicated here to the (29 A) (36 D) which they who (30 D) here have thus far so (21 A) (35 A). It is rather for us to be here dedicated to the great (32 A) remaining before us - that from these (39 A) dead we take increased (16 A) to that (12 A) for which they gave the last full (3 D) of devotion - that we here highly (38 A) that these dead shall not have died in (26 D) - that this nation, under God, shall have a new birth of (24 A), and that (9 D) of the (4 A), by the people, for the people, shall not (28 D) from the (25 A).
